

The basis for the selection includes: the significance of the proposed subject matter for the lecture; the appropriateness of the proposed subject matter to the elected lecturer; the ability and acquiescence of the selected lecturer to compose a distinguished archival document which appears in the *Journal of the American Helicopter Society*; the outstanding career of the lecturer; and the willingness of the lecturer to present his or her lecture to the Society chapters across the country.
